REQUIREMENTS FOR FORMATTING MATERIALS:

Materials that correspond to the thematic areas of the conference, which have not been previously published and contain new scientific results, will be accepted for publication.

Abstracts of **1-3 pages** of A4 format, printed using a text editor Microsoft Word with the extension *.doc; margins – **2 cm** all. Font – **Times New Roman**, font size - **14 pt**, line spacing – **1 cm**, paragraph indent – **1 cm**, width alignment.

Latin names of plants should be given in italics. One should clarify the relevance of the theme; research results, conclusions. The file name must correspond to the surname of the first author (Nesterenko – Zayavka, Nesterenko – Teza). Authors are responsible for the content and authenticity of the materials. The Organizing Committee has the right to carry out technical editing of the submitted materials.

All participants will get a hyperlink on the specified e-mail to join the video conference via Zoom.

Participants who want to report using a presentation must send the report topic to be included in the program.
